Let it be The applicant's organization must be recognized by and represented within the Resolved:

Graduate and Professional Student Council General Assembly.

Let it be The applicant's organization must have eligibility (voting delegate status) within Resolved:

the Graduate and Professional Student Council before the opening of the Travel

Awards period.

If at least one person from that organization is present at that GA meeting, then Let it be

Let it be Before the first GA meeting of the year, all organizations are considered eligible. Resolved:
