## A Resolution in Favor of Increasing the Number of Temporary Employment (H-1B) Visas

Presented by Fernando Lavalle and Brenna Lin on March 6, 2018

Whereas: The Graduate and Professional Student Council exists to govern and to serve

as the voice of all graduate and professional students at Texas A&M

University.

Whereas: The H-1B program allows companies in the U.S. to temporarily employ

foreign workers in occupations that require highly specialized knowledge. [1]

Whereas: The H-1B visa has an annual numerical limit "cap" of 65,000 visas each fiscal

year. The first 20,000 petitions filed on behalf of beneficiaries with a U.S.

master's degree or higher are exempt from the cap. [2]

And More than 350,000 [3] student visas were issued for 2017, which means more

Whereas: than 80% of international students that obtain higher degrees from U.S.

universities will not be able to stay in the U.S. and work after graduation.
