Resolution in Support of Increased Funding to the Becky Gates Children's Center

Presented by Keya Mukherjee and Matthew J. Etchells on April 17, 2018

Whereas: The Graduate and Professional Student Council exists to govern and to serve as

the voice of all graduate and professional students at Texas A&M University.

Whereas: There exists expensive and inadequate childcare options available to graduate and

professional students off campus at Texas A&M University and the only childcare

facility on campus is the Becky Gates Children's Center.

Whereas: Currently, the center takes in 165 children per year between the ages of 12 months

to 5 years. Of the total intake 37% are children of students on campus, 41% faculty, and 22% staff. Out of the 37%, graduate students make up 32% and they

are not considered a priority.

Whereas: The cost of having a child at the center is \$800.00 per month. Students at Texas

A&M University can get a \$100 discount, but a limit of 71 students at a time means childcare is expensive for most graduate students who have to seek external

childcare providers.

Whereas: As of March, 2018 there are 220 children on the waitlist with a typical waiting

time to be enrolled of 1 to 1.5 years. This makes the childcare facilities available on campus inadequate to meet the needs of the graduate and professional student

populations.

And During the March 21st Graduate and Professional Student Leader Communications

Group (GPSLCG) meeting with Erica Ritter, director of the Becky Gates

Children's Center, she expressed her interest in expanding the number of children taken in every year. However, a lack of funding from the University to the center makes it difficult to do so. The budget needed to run the center comes from our tuition fees. Out of that, 80% of their budget is allocated towards paying staff.

Let it be Resolved:

The Graduate and Professional Student Council at Texas A&M University requests Texas A&M University to increase funding to the Becky Gates Children's Center for the purpose of reducing the amount paid by graduate students for childcare and to expand the square footage of the current Becky Gates Children's Center.
